### 1. Call to Order

Meeting called to order at 5:35 pm.

## 2. Approval of Agenda

Agenda was unanimously approved after adding following additional points: Presentation by Gender Advocacy and Discussion on Judith Woodsworth's comments in Link.

## 3. Approval of Minutes

Erik and Mathew told that there were some grammatical mistakes in the last Meeting Minutes which needs to be corrected. So, Minutes will be approved after correction in next council meeting.

## 4. Presentation by 'Gender Advocacy'

The Gender Advocacy representatives told the council about the problems they are facing as staff of gender advocacy centre. They requested GSA's help by sending an email to graduate students about their Special General Meeting. Erik suggested that a neutral, unbiased and simple informational email can be send to students informing about the Special Meeting of Gender Advocacy Center.

## 5. Presentation by Mathew MacDonald

Mathew MacDonald informed the council that he applied for Sustainable Action Fund. since GSA is not a contributing member, hence their application got rejected because all the applicants are graduate students. So, he requested GSA to contribute in some manner like referendum.

Erik suggested including few undergraduate students in their proposal to be applicable for this funding. GSA is already working on a very tight budget and it would be difficult to support this fund with the present funding of GSA. About referendum, since sustainability is a very important issue, it can be decided in GA whether to impose additional fee on students or not.

#### 6. Report of Survey Committee

The survey report submitted by Zafar was circulated in Council. Erik, Mathew and Roddy commented that the report is not completely informative and suggested to have more detailed report with demographic breakdown. Since, Zafar was not present in the meeting to explain the Survey Report and also all the members of survey committee were not able to

## 7. Budget Approval

In the proposed budget submitted by Budget Committee there was a deficit \$23,000. In order to have a balanced budget, the council discussed each expenditure item in the budget and the amount allocated to each item. During the discussions some items were completely rejected and some amounts were modified. The discussions concluded with a budget with reasonable deficit of \$5410.

MOTION - Faisal - BIRT the Council approve the Budget with the changes suggested today. Erik seconded. All in favor. Motion PASSED.

The approved Budget as of 29<sup>th</sup> October 2009 is attached at the end of minutes.

#### 8. Report of By-law Committee

Roddy informed that an email requesting the suggestions on new by-laws was sent to all graduate students. The mail contained both the old By-Laws and new proposed By-Laws. Mah informed that there will be an open Hearing and Forum to discuss the changes in by-laws on 12, 13 and 20 November. Erik suggested that we need to advertise it strongly because later on during GA it might get rejected and all the efforts might get thrown out. For this Mah requested all the council members to be familiar with both the By-law versions and be present in the hearing and forum so as to be completely part of the process and make the by-law changes successfully.

Erik informed the Council about about the comments that Dr.Judith Woodsworth made in Link about privatization of the University.
