

GSA 2025-2026 General Elections Nomination Form

Eligibility for Office:

To run for an elected position at the GSA, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- be currently enrolled in a graduate program at Concordia University;
- must not hold an elected position with the following organizations:
 - CUFA (*Concordia University Faculty Association*);
 - CUPFA (*Concordia University Part-Time Faculty Association*);
 - CREW (Concordia Research and Education Workers Union);
 - Any GSA Sub-Association (faculty and/or departmental);
 - Any other GSA club.
- must not have held more than 2 consecutive terms as a GSA Executive.

For Director Positions:

Nominations for each Director candidate must be signed by a minimum of ten (10) GSA members in good standing from the faculty that they are seeking to represent.

For Executive Positions:

Nominations for each Executive candidate must be signed by a minimum of fifteen (15) GSA members in good standing, from which there must be at least one (1) GSA member from each faculty including at least one (1) member in an individualized program.
